Eligibility Requirements:

All students, female and male, who meet the following requirements are encouraged to apply.

- ◆ You must be a current resident of the Arlington, Stanwood, Camano Island or La Conner area OR be a graduate of Lakewood, Arlington, Stanwood, Lincoln Hill, or La Conner High Schools.
- ◆ You must have completed at least 2 years of study at an accredited college or university by June 2023 and have verifiable plans to continue upper-division or master's level post-graduate work at an accredited 4-year college or university in the fall of 2023.
- ◆ You must submit all items listed below for consideration.
- ◆ All submissions must be postmarked on or before Saturday, April 29, 2023.

Application Requirements—include ALL of the following in your application envelope:

All submissions must be postmarked on or before Saturday, April 29, 2023. Incomplete submissions, submissions that do not adhere to the directions below or submissions postmarked after April 29, 2023 cannot be considered.

Letters of recommendation must be mailed not emailed.

1. Completed AAUW Stanwood-Camano Branch 2023 Scholarship Application Form (following page).
2. Official copy of ALL your college transcripts (no photocopies).
3. Two confidential letters of recommendation; **mailed not emailed.**
 - One from an instructor or counselor at your college or university and
 - One from a person in your high school or college community
 - Each inserted in a sealed envelope with the writer's signature on the flap
4. A 300-word essay written by you that describes your relationship to our mission. This hard copy document must be typed and double-spaced with one-inch margins all around. The word count must be noted at the top right hand corner of the page.
5. A brief personal statement written by you that describes:
 - Your future plans and goals,
 - Accomplishments and community contributions,
 - Current and past employment or volunteer work you've done,
 - Circumstances influencing your financial need, and
 - Any other information you want to include for the scholarship committee's consideration.
