Clarifications	<p>It has been brought to our attention that there are some wonderings about homework expectations. Please read the items below that explain these two expectations.</p> <p>There will be different parts to keep track of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Reading-Read 400 minutes a month, fill in, and have an adult initial the minutes read on the reading calendar. If your student attends an after school program they may read and have their calendar signed there.2. Math: Students have/will be given pages to complete as an optional activity. These will let you know what we're working on in math. <p>~Today your child came home with two reading and two math papers. This should only be completed if school is canceled . You will be informed from the district if this is the case. We will hold a zoom meeting that your teacher will send a link through Remind to access. This was an attempt to have a plan in place because of the weather forecast.</p>
Reading and Writing	We are in the beginning of Unit 2, the Interaction of Nature and Culture this month. Students will be practicing the writing process to complete narrative stories.
Testing	Mid-year iReady testing will occur in the middle of the month. This will let us know about progress being made. Results will be shared during March conferences.
Math	This month the study is Place Value, Addition, and Subtraction with a focus on learning how to round numbers to the nearest hundred, thousand, and ten thousand.
Caring School Community	Each week we are continuing to randomly select a Spotlight Student. When chosen, that student will bring information home regarding how it works.
Birthdays	This month our celebration will occur on January 27th from 2:00-2:30. Both classes celebrate together. There are 42 students in all. Please let your child's teacher know if you are sending in treats!
