

Tutorial/Teaching PROJECT

PHASE 1: Choose one thing that you want to teach other students. Ask yourself, “What do I know more about than most other people?” Some ideas to get you thinking below:

- Shooting a foul shot
- Grooming a horse
- Throwing a special pitch
- Building a rollercoaster in Minecraft
- Making a French braid
- Choosing a place to throw a crab trap
- Dancing a special way
- Paddling a canoe
- Planting a flower or a crop
- Making a hat
- Drawing a face
- Making a bracelet

PHASE 2: Make a plan to teach that skill to your classmates.

- **First:** On a web or in a document write out the list of steps using one or two words for each step. ON TIME DATE _____
- **Second:** Check with a friend to see if the steps make sense and that you have them in the correct order. ON TIME DATE _____
- **Third:** Write out explaining details for each step so that your tutorial teaches and explains clearly. ON TIME DATE _____
- **Fourth:** Gather the pictures, video, or other media you might need to teach your tutorial clearly. ON TIME DATE _____
- **Fifth:** Choose a format to create your tutorial in. You may use iMovie, PowerPoint, Google Presentation, Pow Toon, or another. Choose your format carefully so that you are successful. ON TIME DATE _____
- **Sixth:** Create your tutorial. ON TIME DATE _____

PHASE 3: Do a practice run of your tutorial with a friend. Ask them to give you feedback on your tutorial. Edit and revise so the tutorial is clear, easy to follow, and teaches. You have done it right when you have taught someone how to do something new. ON TIME DATE - _____

PHASE4: Turn in your finished tutorial ready to present to your class.

COMPLETION CHECKLIST:

- My tutorial has an introduction that tells my audience what skill they will learn
- The skill I am teaching is broken into 3-8 steps (ask if you need more and we can discuss it)
- The steps are in order
- Each step is clearly shown AND explained
- Everything in my tutorial is there for a reason – and helps teach the skill
- Have I removed anything extra that does not belong in my tutorial
- I have visuals in my tutorial (pictures or video)
- My tutorial is at least 0:45 long and not longer than 3:00 minutes
- Smooth flow – no obvious starts and stops, it is clearly presented
- Audio – it is easy to hear the tutorial
