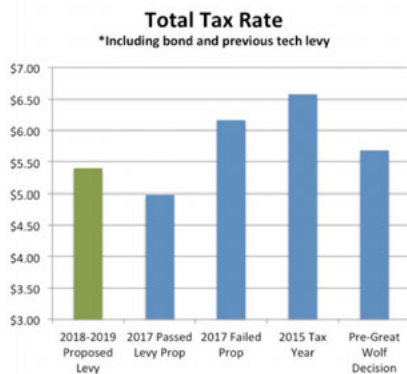
# LEVY

## QUICK FACTS

- **2-Year Levy**
- **2018 & 2019**
- **Educational & Operations Levy**
- **\$1,250,000 Each Year**
- **\$2.50 per thousand tax rate**
- **Less than Pre-Great Wolf rates**

**Is this a new tax?** No. It replaces the expiring 2017 levy.

**How will this affect my taxes?** The estimated tax rate is lower than Pre-Great Wolf, lower than the failed 2017 levy. The estimated combined tax rate (levy and bond) is \$ 5.44 per thousand.



## LEVIES ARE FOR LEARNING

Levies pay for programs and staff either not funded or underfunded by the state or other agencies. Some examples include:

- Teachers (providing low class sizes and more elective offerings including, aviation, AVID, culinary arts, music, drama, art, etc.)
- Teaching Assistants (K-2 classroom support, math support, library services)
- Extra-curricular athletics and activities
- Enhanced Food Services
- Enhanced Highly Capable, Special Ed, etc. Services
- Field Trips
- Technology (Phone, internet, website, security, computers, classroom technology)
- Safe, secure and well-equipped and maintained facilities

Levy revenues will be focused primarily on staff related expenditures; positions and compensation. Teacher wages are crucial in retaining and recruiting quality teachers to ensure student success..

Additional levy resources will also continue to support the ongoing regular operations of technology within the district. This levy does not include any new deployments of equipment.
