La Conner School Board discussing levies

LA CONNER — The La Conner School Board will meet Thursday to continue discussing upcoming levy proposals after meeting with members of the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community.

The board met Monday evening to discuss sending both a replacement educational programming and operations levy and a replacement technology levy to voters in a February special election. But members decided they needed more information from the Swinomish tribe about potential future contributions to the district.

District representatives are set to meet with tribal representatives Thursday afternoon, and the board will resume its levy discussion in a public meeting at 5:30 p.m.

Districts preparing to ask voters to approve levy proposals, including La Conner, Burlington-Edison and Concrete school districts, have until Friday afternoon to submit their information to the Skagit County Auditor's Office.
