# Strategies We Can Use for Continuous Learning

- Regular scheduled appointments via Zoom, telephone or other platform.



- Online programs (such as, **MobyMax** IXL,



- Online classroom platforms (such as Google Classroom or other)

- Office Hours (Open times when you can contact a staff member.)



# Paraeducators

Paraeducators may be making contact. All paraeducators:

- 1) Know your student's IEP
- 2) Are in regular contact with your student's case manager
- 3) Have a learning plan of what the teacher wants to get done in the learning session.

# Tasks for Teaching and Therapy Staff During Student Contact

- Teach new skills
- Review recently acquired skills
- Focus on IEP Goals
- Support General Education 'Classroom' Work
- For High School Students, credit completion
- IEP and Evaluation Meetings

”Hmmm....  
So how is this different from services other  
students are getting?”

For special education students, your student is getting regular contact and support from the special education team to help with academic progress and IEP goals.

How this time is used is up to the case manager, student, and you as parent.

# *What Can Parents Do?*

- Your involvement is **KEY** to your student's success!
- Read Read Read with your student. Discuss the reading. Help choose the reading if appropriate.
- Be sure you're in contact with your student's teacher. Appear with your student during at least a portion of the teacher contact time.
- Be sure your STUDENT is doing the work.
- Offer feedback to the teaching staff during the regular meetings. What's working well? What are some improvements to make?
